*Poinsettias: Toxic Holiday myths debunked*

- Scientific research from the Ohio State University has proven the poinsettia to be non-toxic to both humans and pets. All parts of the plant, including leaves and sap, were tested.
- According to POISINDEX, the national info center for poison control centers, a child would have to ingest 500-600 leaves in order to exceed the experimental doses that reflected no toxicity.
- A study done by Children's Hospital in Pittsburgh and Carnegie Mellon University found that out of 22,793 reported poinsettia exposures there was no significant toxicity. The study used national data collected by the American Association of Poison Control Centers.
- However, the poinsettia is not meant to be eaten and can cause discomfort. Therefore, the plant should be kept out of reach of young children and curious pets. — *Information courtesy Flowers by Sue.*
