Use powder to put a stop to shine.

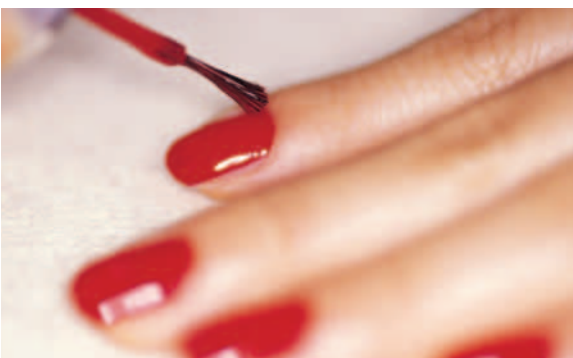
Once you use your powder, gently blend your beauty products. This way, your makeup will gently enhance your natural beauty without looking "obvious."
